 to lead us into all truth, and to bring us unto salvation
 at the last: we doe also give up of ourselves unto God in
 Christ Jesus, avouching him to be our God, & God of our
 children, humbly desiring him to bestow upon us that
 grace, whereby both we and they may walk before him
 as becomes his covenant-people forever.
 we doe also give up of ourselves one unto another in the
 Lord, according to the will of God, engaging our selves
 to walk together as a right ordered Church of Christ
 in all the ways of his worship according to the rule
 of his most holy word, promising in brotherly love
 faithfully to watch over one another's souls, and to sub-
 mit of selves to the government of Christ in his Church
 attending upon all his holy administrations, accord-
 ing to the order of the Gospel, so far as God hath or may direct
 us by his word and spirit.
