 Secondly voted that twenty six pounds thirteen shillings and  
 four pence Lawfull money be Raised to Defray y<sup>e</sup> Charge of  
 mending the ways this year  
 Thirdly it was put to vote to be if the town will give  
 to the selectmen to draw so much money out of the town's  
 Treasurers hands as to pay the Schoolmaster for four months  
 schooling and board and it passed in the Negative  
 fourthly Samuel Webster was Chosen to Repair the pound in  
 the west parish and make Return to y<sup>e</sup> town  
 fifthly it was put to vote whether y<sup>e</sup> town will abate  
 Kimball's Rate for y<sup>e</sup> last year & it passed in y<sup>e</sup> Negative
