it was put to vote wheather y<sup>e</sup> town will give Instructions to y<sup>e</sup> Treasurer of said town to procure the Constable that are or shall be Chosen wh<sup>o</sup> Refuse to Serue and the vote passed in y<sup>e</sup> negative

Espe<sup>cially</sup> to Jame Baley Constable of the town of Bradford and appointed by the Seelct men of said town to warn this town meeting Greeting in his majestic Name you are hear by Required forthwith to warn the freeholders and other Inhabitants of said town qualified to vote as the Law Direct that they meet together at the west meeting house in Do town on tuesday the twenty Second Day of may Instant at two of the Clock in the after noon to Chuse Constable for to Serue the town this present year those that have Serue in to that office this year having Refused to take y<sup>e</sup> oaths by Law appointed Constables to take also to Se what Instruction the town will give to the Seelct men what manner of a pound they will build and how much money will raise to build a pound with and where they will have it sett also to Se if y<sup>e</sup> town will build a Stone Bridges over Youfers Brook Near Robert Mullukens where y<sup>e</sup> bridge now is at y<sup>e</sup> Charge of the whole town and if that pass in y<sup>e</sup> affirmative to Chuse a Committee to Ser the work Effecter as also to Chuse a Surveyer of high way in y<sup>e</sup> Room of Len<sup>th</sup> Benja Gage if he Refuse to take y<sup>e</sup> oaths by Law appointed and also to Se if y<sup>e</sup> town will give Instructions to the Seelct men to give order to y<sup>e</sup> Treasurer of said town to pay unto Mr Nath<sup>l</sup> Peasey Sargant Eight pound, Seventeen Shilling and nine pence for four months schooling as also to y<sup>e</sup> Rev<sup>d</sup> m<sup>r</sup> Baley for his binding him to term y<sup>e</sup> same agreed with also to allow to Joseph Kimball Eighteen and eight pence for two Shirts he provided for Jonathan Pifer and make a Return hearof with your Doings there in to us the Subscribers at or before the time appointed for y<sup>e</sup> meeting Votes at Bradford may y<sup>e</sup> 10<sup>th</sup> 1753 in 26 year of his Reign
