At a Legal town meeting held by the Inhabitants of the town of Bradford September the 18th 1753 Capt Benj^y Mullicken Moderator of said meeting voted and allowed to Constable James Baley for warranting y^e widows pluckout out of town and Returning the warrant - - - - -

voted to Capt Mullicken for keeping Martha Simmons from y^e twentieth of March to y^e 18th of Sep^r 26 weeks - - - - - 0 = 2 = 6

voted to Capt Mullicken for Serving as a Treasurer in Town - - - - - 2 = 8 = 0

voted for y^e Support of Jonathan Puffer from y^e twentieth Day of March to y^e 18th Day of September 26 weeks - - - - - 0 = 8 = 0

voted to Capt Jonathan Baley for to Keep y^e pound in good Repair for y^e space of two years - - - - - 2 = 8 = 0

voted to Joseph Kimball & Stephen woodman for preblating y^e Line between Bradford & Boxford four Shillings two Shillings to Each man - - - - - 0 = 2 = 8

voted to Thomas Kimball & Joseph Kimball for preblating y^e Line between Adover & Bradford one Shilling Six pence to Each man - - - - - 0 = 4 = 0
