

The first men chasidoring the great hurt and damage  
is done yearly by swine.

For therof ordene that all swines where baits agaynt the Cattell  
inge to the inhabitanets of mesinate shall be sufficiently yoked  
the yokes being two foot one may in twenty inches the other  
way on the yoke of the swine yod hys for every boord ther  
which is to be done by the fift of aquall next dayne and so  
to be kept yoked until the fift daye when he gathere  
any hys leys his yokes or be seuen yokes to fift. That tyme  
the owners of them shall forthwith yoke them and if  
any shall neglect to doe her duty therin he shall pay  
her as aforesaid for often as they shall be seuen yokes  
the owners of such hys having her stede of thys being  
unyoked the one half to the paxton and the  
other half to the rye of the Cattell

We do also againt yester daie to see to the execution  
of this ordene our to take note of such numbers of hys as  
shall be seuen i efture according to the daire and shall give  
notis every such boord to one of us or me of the paxton men  
within two daies after comyng such paxton shall be found  
delinquente to gyde with the number of hys that abyde  
~~unyoked~~ it was agone by y paxton men of mesinate that wch  
it was that therof about hys shall stan by this evengyn  
ff a farther ordene that is every boord or swine  
in any other field the owners of such boord or swine shall  
pay one shilling for the fift boord and two shillings for the  
second boord and so to pay one shilling almoost until it  
to faire shillings for one boord : and after next faire shillings  
a sume as ofte as they are before us aforesaid yfounded the same  
about such boord wher they may be sufficient against ther  
by Cattell and yeld paxton : and if any such boord or swine  
 hath taken to go into any field to fift in the aforesaid  
domaine without such shillings or boord at myt and doth  
strayn them : the owners of them shall pay five shillings  
any that shall impound them and for sum time to fift  
long as the swine is in the field
