

At a legall Town meeting gyvenary the 11. 1681.

1. it was voted in grant that when a town meeting is notified and the Towns met together that none shall neglect the meeting without liberty granted by the Moderator or the penalty of 12 pence here.
2. that no town acts shall be of value that is voted after June 1st
3. that Robert huskins shall have thirty shillings allowed him for to find me fims & find wood this year
4. that those that do not come to work all the high ways when they are notified by the wardens shall pay 3 shillings four pence for 1 day & so forth in my repairing all time and also granted in for proportionable after the rate of 3 shillings 4 pence a day for work as they come short of a day work by coming late & be not continuing to work the whole day

At a legall meeting of the 11th Nov. 1681
wks was appointed to give notice to such as have
walk about the minut all here whereby they may cut
it out they shall take with the Constable.

At a legall Town meeting the foreward day of
march 1681 Thomas Dow was agreed with to get up
of four one the ministrals sum by the middle of
April for which hee is to cut for the prison chales
walks of his estate & for the 30th hee is to have
10m prison chales to the value of 1 pound
the whole which hee is to have for getting up the
fore he getting the stipes can bringing it into place
