March 27 1668

A legall meeting of the Inhabitants of Rury Village by nomination of the Justices was held at which it was ordered that Robert hejolline Constable of Rury Village should have free passage to the Court and should be allowed his costs without any mediation from the Court or any one of them by enclosing the same with any fine provided that the said Robert hejolline & his brother John hejolline do stand surety for the same. And it was further ordered that the said Robert hejolline should be allowed his costs of the above-mentioned meeting of the Inhabitants of Rury Village the same day it was ordered by a generall vote that the same instructions given to the select men in the year of our late 1668 for the choosing one of the ninetene here for ordering the Courne affairs shall be things & instructions for the year 68
