 1st John wales chosen for Constable for year
 2nd for select men wales chosen shu walter william haining
 Joseph palmer Joseph auld and John Simmon
 3rd wales then chosen to locate a lane & vicarage in 7000 sines
 4th locations same standing and Dick Hall for 1/2 year Ensign
 5th Nathaniel Westas and John Hall's wife chosen for 1/2 year
 6th James and Elizabeth

It was then voted and granted that Samuel Standing should
 take care to get a tenne brand made and to have it at his house
 and that none were to be granted out of Capt. Cutler
 the day and date as above mentioned & wales voted and granted that
 all others who are that is who are run over in England, Wales and
 more abel or any other who are of it shoull pay for & new halfe pence for
 not at the rate of 1/2 shall pay for & new halfe pence for
 Lane both to ministers and townes

It was then voted and granted that the vicarage should
 be the town is engaged to provide for & maintain in
 it to be good and that every man to have his portion
 in 10000 sines

It was then mentioned and granted that the
 should be ten pounds added to the vicarage in each year
 maintenance to be paid as before and to begin wth 1st next year
 It was then granted to Samuel wales that he should have a
 place at 1/2 of the vicarage in 1/2 of the vicarage in a lane
 for his wife and children
