

January 6: 1690 at a legall town meeting in Bradford  
John was chosen for constabell John Wood, and for selectmen  
was chosen David Haselthorn John Gray Joseph Holy  
Abraham Haselthorn and Richard Kimball senior  
To see to the <sup>own</sup> synods occasions was chosen Richard Hall  
and Gershom Haselthorn / for surveyors of fens and high  
ways was chosen Nathan Woodst. Thomas Kimball Joseph  
Patent and William Savory: then was chosen John Hardy  
to be collector of Staves

March 18: 1690 at a legall town meeting of the inhabi-  
tants of Bradford: It was then voted that  
there should be a galley built in our meeting house

January 9: 1691, 92: at a legall town meeting of the  
inhabitants of Bradford: then was chosen for constabell  
Samuell Bondy: for selectmen was chosen David  
Stickney David Haselthorn and Samuell Haselthorn  
Joseph Holy and Thomas Hardy senior: To see to  
the synods occasions was chosen Richard Hall and  
Gershom Haselthorn: and for surveyors and fens was  
chosen Nathansell Gage Richard Kimball junior  
Francis Woodier and James Palmer

March 5: 1692 at a legall town meeting of the inhabi-  
tants of Bradford: then was chosen for constabell Richard Kimball (junior) and for selectmen  
was chosen David Haselthorn Richard Kimball (senior) John Hardy Joseph Holy and  
John Woodier: for surveyors and fens was chosen Thomas Woodst John Boynton  
Samuell Bondy and Samuell Stickney junior: for a thing may Samuell Stickney (senior)  
Palmer and Richard Hall: for townes clerk David Haselthorn: constabell  
assistant Abraham Haselthorn: to be collectors of waight's and measures was  
Samuell Stickney (senior) for to see to the synods occasions Richard Hall and  
Robert Haselthorn

March 24: 1693 at a legall town meeting of the inhabi-  
tants of Bradford: It was then voted by the major part of the town to give the select-  
men full power to make such orders and impose such fines as they shall think  
necessary for the benefit of the town
