

At a lawfull Towne meeting of the freemen and other
inhabitant ^{of the Towne} of Bradford, the March 31. 1698 / there was chosen for
Constable for the yeare ensuing Edmund John Juny: at the same time
was chosen for select men: David Haseltine and Josiah Baly: John Baynton
Coryell Richard Kimblett: and Josiah Yalwood: then was chosen for a Constable
Cliff David Haseltine: for Circuaries of highways and fence views, was
Chosen Danell Gage Bro: David Kimblett: William Worth and John Madinford
for trypling and was chosen Robert Haseltine and Samuel Juny: to see to
the ^{lawfull} occasions was chosen Gautham Haseltine and Salomon Wood

At the same time there was a Constable chosen to trade wth the severall
parishes which were the present select men

At the same time was chosen Thomas May to lay out the money
chosen by the Towne to buy the land 3. miles w^{est} of Bradford
which was John Juny: David Haseltine: Richard Kimblett

At a lawfull Towne meeting of the freemen and other inhabitant of the
Towne of Bradford the 24. of April 1698: At the same time was chosen for the
time to come the select men shall be yearly a newly chosen who shall have full
power to receive the yearly salary: this shall be the yearly due to the
Constable out of the Constable: and to receive the same yearly salary
for the same time it was voted that for the time to come the select men
shall have full power to take or sell the price of the graine that
shall be yearly payed in to the Constable at the yearly rate of

At the same time Robert Haseltine was chosen for the year 1699
and to receive the yearly salary out of the Constable this yeare

At the same time It was voted that for the time to come the Constable
and Synners his wood shall yearly be bought in to the first of every year by
just proportion the one halfe at all first the market of October yearly
the other halfe to be brought in at or before the first of February and so
continuously and also every man may buy wood in or out of the year and have
custome of the same as the be at a market at any time in

at the same time It was voted that such persons or persons as shall
expressly or refuse so buying in the first proportion of wood according
time being six shillings per cord: and so the proportion of wood according
quantity: to be payed in wth due way of order: and at the year
the Constable shall have his yearly salary: and such as refuse
to paye: the select men are to grant allowance to the Constable to
select men: who are to receive the wood for the same to the Constable

at the same time It was voted that the wood for this last yeare which is
not yet bought in: shall be bought in at or before the last of June
1699: or else fall under the above mentioned penalty
