town used in the former meeting, and approbated and the select men
are here by comparison to approve the inhabitation of sd town for the
same only what was set downe for the scoule matter and hauch marton
2ly It was then noted, that from the time of Acharahs beinge taken
leavie and so forward: from time to time: all such parance or making
of pnde this children or servants to scoule: shal pay towards the
work for such as leave to use: such as leave to weigh shal pay four
pnde for work: towards the scouling of said children and servants
3ly It was then noted that the four parand: six children then
granted to the town: shal be used on the inhabitation of sd
town: to pay such as have: or shal be employed at scouling

It was then agreed and noted that whereas Samuel stickney more
hath pressed the town in an action of det for not paying the sum
of one pound nineteen shillings it was then noted agreed to stand
of the case in a course of law
1ly it was then agreed and noted that the select men who were
summoned to appear by sd stickney at Newbery namely Capt
David Roseltine, Ensigne Joseph Baly and Philip Attwood were
appointed by the town as agents to defend the cause and to make
choice of any attorney to undertake the answering of sd action
upon the towns cost
2ly it was noted that the aforesaid agents had duly paid to agree
with the sd stickney and others concerned about the scoule matter
as they should doe: Courts
