of the minister: 3. Capt David Rosolins and Insind John  
orony would <sup>made</sup> choyse of to goo a beede to Inquire after  
some person to assiste in the work of the minister and upon  
good Informatioun to invite some person — — —

At a legall town moting of the hoodholders and otherr the  
Inhabitants of the the town of Bradford held august  
the 7. 1405. it was then proposid to the town whether  
they did take such a licken to m<sup>r</sup> hald us to Inply him  
In the work of the minister agreed it was pot to m<sup>r</sup>  
and it passed on the affairment — — —  
I noted that if m<sup>r</sup> hald should see good to take up with  
the towns proposioun so as to correspond his labors amongst us  
a yeare that the town would give him thirty poundes  
the end half in may and the otherr half in george  
as many and his bedding cleave — — —
