

At a legall Towne meeting of the freholders and others
the Inhabitants of the towne of Bradford holden February
13 day 1708 the towne did pass a vote to Build a house on
the personage for a minister the house to be 46 foot
long 20 foot wide 15 foot Stood. Said house to be
built and finished within 3. years Comencing from the
time of the Towns agreement with the S. minister if
Consent to live in a personage house

It was also noted that if the said minister do not incline to live
in a personage house that then the former vote to be
void and the Towne do engage to pay the S. minister
one hundred pounds. within two years after the Towns
indenting with him that is to say 50. pounds a year
in money

It was then proposed to the town to show their willingness
to give the Reverent Mr Joseph Stevens a call to settle with
us in this towne as our settled minister it was put to
vot and passed on the aforesaid

at the same time Capt David Hordtine and Left Tommy
and Left Richard Kembell were made choyes of as a
Community to meet with Mr Stevens and acquaint him with
the minds of the towne

At a legall town meeting of the freholders and others
the Inhabitants of the towne of Bradford holden December
31. day 1707. for approving and allowing of town
charges then was noted and granted the following p^{er} stickles
to Left Richard Kembell: five pounds: nine shillons
to Left John Tommy: ten shillons: to Jonathan
Kembell: five shillons: to Joseph Palmer: 0 4 6:
to Capt Davids Hordtine: Six shillons: to Robert
Hordtine: six 2. shillons: to John Coynton: 2. shillons
to Thomas Kembell: 3. shillons to Josim Joseph. Cady
3. shillons 6. six shillons to by a boock for the
towne
