At a Legall town meeting of the freeholders and others
the inhabitants of the town of Bradford holden May 3: 1708
the town do then make chage of Justice Joseph Bady and

in Symes Linding. it was then voted that the town would
dispay the cost of bying the said Linding to save man
Doran John Tenoy and Joseph Patmore: w^{ch} then made
Chage of - to look after a minister for these or future
Sabath days - on the towns ceast -

at the same time the town do grant unto the select
men to lett out the po^rson^s land belonging to the town
for this po^rson^s year

At a Legall town meeting of the freeholders and others
the inhabitants of the town of Bradford holden May 17: 17
wheras this town hath already voted to give their next
pound in money upon setlement with us one hundred po^r
towne p^resichs the land that was formerly the Remoy
in Symes that then the town will pay the said minister
the above said hundred pounds out of the Land so p^resiched
at the same price that the town bought it and that
said minister shall ^{have} the Refusill of the forty Acres of
out land belonging to the said Linding at the same price
the town now give for it he paying all necessary chage
arising of said p^resich.

It is noted that wheras the town have now p^resiched the
Linding that was formerly the Remoy in Symes now voted
and granted that the town pay unto Justice Joseph Bady
and L^t Richard Kamball and John Kouchens the sum
of Eighty and three pounds and five teen shillings in money
at or before the 22: day of may Instant and also the
sum of Eighty and three pounds and five teen shillings
in money unto the men before named at or before the
22: day of may which will be in the year 1709
together with all necessary chages that shall the
above said men w^{ch} at a beight the said p^resich
