

At a Church meeting of the Brethren Duly warned
held in Bradford July 20: 1708 it was then put to vote
In the Church that the Church Give the Rousement in Thomas
Symms a call In ~~the~~ order to settlement in this town if the
previdence of God make way for the same this vote passed
on the Affirmative as atore John tonny moderator --

At a legal town meeting of the freemen and others the Inhab-
itants of the town of Bradford held July 20 1708 by
agreement from the 5: day of July Instant +
the town did then vote a Concurrence with the Church
choyse of Doan John tonny and Doan Joseph Bay and
Left Richard Korbalt and John Touchens to go to box-
to Infirm the Rousement in Thomas Symms of what
the Church and town had don --

At a legal town meeting of the freemen and others the
Inhabitants of the town of Bradford held July 26: 1708

1. It was then put to vote and passed on the Affirmative that the
next minister that shall settle in this town shall have this
living which is now bought of Mr. Symms heires that is to say
the wharstead at one hundred and twelue paires --
2. It was then voted and passed on the Affirmative that if
the Rousement in Thomas Symms shall in some short time
Remove from this place in any other way then by death
that then he shall Return that living which he hath of
the town unto the town again --
3. It was then voted and passed on the Affirmative
that the town will Give unto the Rousement in Thomas
Symms the same Salary both for quantiti and Speech
that they had voted to Give unto the Rousement in ~~Stadon~~
only to twelue the wood In to Six paires to be payed
for the same Speech of his Salary --
4. It was then voted and passed on the Affirmative that the
same three men which the town spected to by the living
Rousement in Thomas Symms a deed of the wharstead
