3 It was then voted and passed on the agreement the Comity
Committee that would choose to seat the new meeting house
should pay by this Rate that is to say 10 shillings all the
men that are above sixty years etc according to the
Eage and all the Rest of the town according to the
Rate having no respect to the Rates of Sons or Servants

At a legall town meeting of the freeholders and others the
inhabitants of the town of Dead River held January 14th 1709
then voted and passed on the agreement that the Rent
in Symes Rate shall be one payment and that to be
by the last of January

2 It was then voted and passed on the agreement that
whereas the town was granted unto James Joseph Galy
and Left Richard Kimball and John Louchous the sum
of one hundred and sixty and seven pounds and seven shillings
the last payment being to be payed this next may
now voted that it will have this last payment
for one year and what charge of having the aforesaid
money shall amount unto the town will remain

3 then voted that Capt Robert Rosolting and Thomas Kimball
and Richard Kimball were shall be a comity to
