others the inhabitants of the town of Wadford  
held April the 17: 1700. then Capt David Haselkine  
and Thomas Kimball and Johnathan Woodman was  
chosen a comity to view the ground for the new  
intended Road to by foot and are empowered to advise  
the comity which was appointed by the Court for that  
affair and to confer with them about that matter  
and if they can agree with the persons that shall own  
one the Land where the Road may be layed and lay  
out sd Road so fair as it shall be inured to  
all which shall be at the towns cost - - -

At a legal town meeting of the freemen and other the inhabitants

it was then agreed and voted that the present select men should set the  
price of game for this present year that to be payed to the  
Mr Symes for his salary: 2 by vote of John Huchens moderator  
Robert Haselkine Sen for receiving mens k'ings in order to make the  
comity tax that be allowed them shilings per man: the whole thirty by  
the vote of Capt Kimball Justice Gody and John Huchens shall have  
six shilings for going to merty to hire money: also to Dison towny and  
John Huchens four shilings for going presentation and also  
also to Capt Kimball for seris Dunfor the town ~~and~~ eight shilings  
also to David Haselkine for ye like seris eight shilings: also to David  
Haselkine Thomas Kimball and Jonathan Woodman going to Salem Court  
on the towns seris four shilings per man: also to David Haselkine  
another time six shilings: also to Samuel Shickne for ye like seris four shilings  
also that was passed of on the affirmative on the day above writing
