chosen Marshall warden and John Giffing for anything more real chosen  
Moses Mayhew Joseph West Abraham Hestlin & Jonathan Woodman Thomas Bell  
Samuel Herry John Giffing and Nathaniel Walker

At a town meeting of the inhabitants of Bradford held may 18 1711  
Capt Kimball moderator wherein the town voted that shirts should be threat  
and chose to see that the Dabdy be right Dravon of is to be prop  
above the land that next the stand and Ecclesiastical Syntre and to have  
the play be duly Executed: for the ends above said was chosen Capt  
Samuel Herry John Giffing and Nathaniel Walker

At a town meeting largely attended and most fairely  
held following votes passed on the affirmation  
by that Col John Fletcher should be allowed from the town a week  
or two more not exceeding from his saying when he went away  
on the 6 January: for which he was allowed 12 days pay  
by that before day he allowed twenty shillings which was given  
by Captain Herry going daily 3d days 5 - 11 - 0

and so to continue: Noticed that the pitch house be allowed to make of the year  
fashion in the hind part of the west gallery: Noticed that 12 young men  
be allowed to make the hind part of the west gallery per fashion and have it let in  
noticed that there should be no manumission or election: Noticed that each  
of them should be a member of 12 to make up a free fashion in the
