

At a legal Town meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Bradford held March the 10th 1712. 13 Capt Kimball
James Tomny was chosen town Clerk
then was chosen for the west Nathaniel Walker Constable for the west end
of the town and Thomas Coyle for the east end of the town for the
year ensuing the town Exceptor of Robert Muckin and William Sawyer for
Constables in their rooms Samuel Tomny John Giffing Moses Day Thomas
Kimball John Hutchins was chosen select men for the year ensuing
for survey of highways ^{and fences} was chosen Jehuaboy Boynton and Samuel Kimball
for the west end of the town and John Pemberton and William Henry near
for the east end of the town for the year ensuing

for Jythangmen was chosen John Gage son Joseph heul Jo: John Boynton
for Robert hasebtins Johnathan woodman william Landy son Joseph west
James palmer ^{County} for the year ensuing
for Robert Hestlins was chosen John of ^{the} ^{year} ^{ensuing} ^{for} the year ensuing
It was voted and consented to that meet the next Mohobill Stickney
Elizabeth palmer ^{County} was to beannah senior Sarah Hutchins that
they should have liberty to make a seat out the remains staves at the south
Corner of the meeting house to sit in

It was then voted that for time to come and consented to that
our annual town meeting shall begin at ten of the clock in the morning

At a legal Town Meeting of the Inhabitants of the Town
Bradford held April 9th 1713 it was then voted and passed one
affirmative of the present select men should agree with a school
master to teach children & youths to read and to write and
to place him either at the west end of the town or at the east
end of the town whom they are acquainted with the minds of the
Inhabitants of each end of the town to place him in one of
the places for one third of the year and the other two thirds of the town
to have ^{that} proportion of time in schooling afterwards

2^{ly} it was voted & passed that Capt Richard Kimball and
John Griffin and John Gage senior and Deacon Richard Bant
and Samuel Tomny should & were then empowered to divide
high ways that wanted to be mended as well as all Bridges
that wanted to be mended in the country Road within the town
of Bradford to divide them in two equal parts as near as
may be all so to divide the persons in two equal parts which
are to mende so ways — 3^{ly} it was then voted and passed
that if any person or persons shall kill any brown wolf
within the bounds of Bradford if the person belong to the town
then the person or persons shall so killing any wolf or wolf
shall have Ten shillings per head for every wolfe so killed
to be paid by the town (the former vote about the high
ways & division to continue till the town so gave
the same)
