At a Legall Towne Meeting December 22. 1713. These sum's
 which are due to & persons named hereafter were allowed
 and approbated by & Towne of Bradford namely to Constable
 Robert Mullickson for serving Warrants & for his office 0-14-00
 to James Wallmer for & use of his house to ^{School} & back, in 0-10-00
 to Capt Atwood for his house for 3d. service 0-08-00
 to Deacon Tennyson for teaching School 8-10-00
 to Ichabod Boynton for so many weeks as he had or
 shall teach school from & 1st of septemb^r. 1713
 to & last of March Next following to have 3m^o skatings
 for wood to Thomas ^{Sim} Kimball for & School house 25-00-00
 to William Savory Constable for his Service 00-12-00
 to & select M^{en} for making a Rate 05-10-00
 to samuel Hapthire for service dan for & Towne 00-03-00
 to Hezreiah Hapthire for Sweeping & m^onting ^{house} 05-00-00
 to John Hutkins for being Deputy 05-05-00
 Clarke Robert Hapthire and Clarke Thomas Kimball
 were then chosen to agree with & Reverend m^r Thomas
 Simms about & price of graine for his Saltery also to
 attend there at his house when his Rate is pd

At a Legall ^{on 5m^o or 6th} Towne Meeting March 9th 1713
 then was chosen Capt Kimball for Moderator for select men
 were chosen Serjant Nathaniel Walker, Samuel Tenny
 Thomas Carl for John Griffin, David Combs
 for Constable were chosen serj Daniel Hardy & Daniel
 Jagutt. The Towne did then except Robert Mullickson
 to serve as Constable in & room of those two above
 mentioned say Nathaniel Walker was chosen Towne
