 to serve as Constables in the Room of these tow aforesaid
 Nathaniel Walker was Chosen Town Clerk for Surveyors of high
 ways and fence ways was Chosen for the east end of the town
 Samuel Tomny for the ^{and} ^{space} ^{of} ^{the} ^{town} ^{was} ^{Chosen} ^{Capt}
 Richard Kimball and Capt Attwood for Ditching men were
 Chosen John Gage son John West Robert Haseltine son Robert Mulichin
 James Gentry Joseph Weston Samuel Kimball for Herwards or field Drud
