At a Legall Town meeting of the Inhabitants of the Towne of Bridford Meach the 11<sup>th</sup> 1718 Nathaniel 38<sup>th</sup> of this County to fore in this Meach

It was voted and Consented to end the Town did their much Case of Capt Richard Kimball and John Hutchings to Geo and that land and much Report to the Town

At a Legall Town Meeting of the Inhabitants of the Towne of Bridford Meach the 11<sup>th</sup> 1718 Capt Richard Kimball and for Select Men were Chosen John Hutchings John Gage son Dracoon Richard Baily Joseph Hall Thomas Kimball Junr and for Constables were Chosen John Southerton for the East End of the Town Nathaniel Griffing for the west End of the Town

Nathaniel 38<sup>th</sup> was Chosen Town Clerk  
for Surveyors was Chosen for Highways and fences John Woodson Samuel Palmer Joseph Hardy Jun Abrahann Parker for the East end and for the west End was Chosen David Kimball John Hull Robert Hestlings son Thomas Kimball son and for tithing men were Chosen Moses Den son John Boynton son Robert Hestlings Jonathan Woodmen Thomas Baily William Henry nings William Janory Calop Hopkison nings Clerk Thomas Kimball were Chosen for to take Care of the poor

All the above said persons that were Chosen to officie for the year 1718 were sworn to a faithfull Discharge of their Respective offices as the Law Directs ~~and~~ save only son Boynton son Hestlings withern saving this present meeting were from till Monday the fourteenth of march Instant and that all persons Concern are to give there attendance

At a Legall Town Meeting Held by a Townmote from march the 11 to march the 17 = 1718 It was voted and passed of the affirmatives that the Town would Build tow Houses and that the present School house shall be disposed of to help barre the Charge of building the two School Houses

It was voted and Consented to that the Town will build the two School houses at or before the last of october 1718 and then fort the same to be when the Town do have a School master to teach School to be in no other house than those upon the Town and Chary
