

At a Legall Town meeting of the Inhabitants of the Town of Bradford the 8 of Decem 1718 Coynt Kimball Moderator the Town hearing the Memorial of the Committee that was Chosen for to care that the School Houses should be built in each End of the Town

2 It was voted and passed on the Affirmative that the Town would pay twenty four pound twelvet shillings and six pence sent time in January next ensuing the date here of and the other twenty four pound ~~the~~ ten shillings and six pence the next January twelvet month for Building of the School Houses

The Committee chos for the vote of the Town know all men by these presents that whereas we David Kimball and James Baully both of Bradford in the County of Essex in newengland werc agrred with by Robert mulichin and John Hutchings of the same Town and County to build two School Houses to each parsons in and we had obligations from the sd mulichin and Hutchings to leas the sum of thirty two pound money some time in January next Ensuing the date here of we do by these presents declare that we Rest contented and fully satisfied with the out half of the money we werc to have for Building so houses this next January and to stay for the other half till next January followe Dated Decem ber the 8th 1718 as witness our hands this

Know all men by these presents that I Robert Kimball of Bradford in the County of Essex in newengland do fully freely declare that the house which is built in the west End of the Town of Bradford for to teach School in that the sd Towne shall have liberty to Improut the same for the sd purpose so long as the sd house shall stand if it prout to be repairing and as witness my hand
