

- At a Generall Townmeeting march the 5: 1719
- 1 voted and passed out the affirmatives that the Towne did Consent and allow that there shoud be a pound built at either End of the Towne viz that is to say ^{on} Sum where near messes Jons and the others near Samuel Heals if particullor persons would appear to build them upon there own Cost and Charge
 - 2 voted and consented to that there shoud be a Road laid out by the select men from Robert mulchings Lane to Samuel Kingwell nether for the Towne Ends upon the Towne Cost and Charge
 - 3 it was voted and consented to in answer to Mr Symes is desire about decking and plastering the Meeting House It is left to the Consideration of the select men until the next Towne meeting care them to make no part to the Towne about that matter
 - 4 It was voted and consented to that the present select men shoud set the Meeting House If Occasion call for It
 - 5 It was voted and consented to that John Geyd Senior and Nathaniel Shepher ^{Senior} that no wood nor Limber be Cote nor Carried off the parting Land and so prosicute say that both according to Law
 - 6 It was voted and consented to that there shoud be a Toll Book to Enter all mares in and that it be kept in the Towne Clerk hand

At A Logall Town meeting of the inhabitants of the Towne of Bradford the 7 of may 1719

It was voted and consented to that the select men shoud have power to raise money for the necessity of the Relieving of the widow Mary wallinford

2 then Towne did then make Cons of John Huthings as Agent to Jack Cox about her Estate that the Towne may have it towards her maintenance that is to say the widow wallinford is Estate

At a logall town meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Bradford the 17 1719 Capt Richard Kimball was chosen to Represent 3^d Town at a Court at Tolson this was given to act in the towns behalf with respect to a way desired to be laid out through Bradford according to his best discretion

At a Logall Townmeeting September the 24: 1719 Capt. Samuel ^{Senior} Moderator = Capt Richard Kimball was chosen to Represent 3^d Town at a Court at Newbury this select Court to act in the towns behalf with respect to a way desired to be laid out to Bradford according to his best discretion

It was voted and passed out the affirmatives that the select men shoud purchase a school master to attend the Freeing school in Bradford for the time of six months between this time and the last march next ensuing
