whereas Moses Day and Daniel Gage did make an offer that if the Town would signifie their desire that the sd Moses Day and Daniel Gage should have a ferry At the place where sd Gage hath kept a ferry for some time provided these men or their heirs and successors do provide weys out thro' one East and Chery wtz that the sd Moses Day doo find a way from the land that getth towards his house from the Gages to find it through his land to the Country Road as it godth to and oute and that sd Daniel Gage find a way from sd ferry to the Country Road at Capt at wood Birch house and also sd land that is betwixt neath sd Gage and John Gage

that then the Towne do desire this ferry may be settled out sd Moses day and out sd Daniel Gage and their heirs forever

4 by it was voted and passed in the Affirmative that if the Court did settle the ferry out sd Moses Day and out Daniel Gage and their heirs forever that then the Towne would give them five pound and the five pound is to be paid to these men some time in December one thousand seven hundred and twenty

5 by it was voted and consented to to make the Road from Bradford to Andover ^{via} from Samuel Hestlines by Capt John Barker to the widow Allons Corner where they goe to Boston and from thence from Andover to Bradford by Capt Atwood Birch house and so to Samuel Hestlines Capt Richard Kimball and Clark Thomas Kimball with a nothrs wises mans for to measure these weys upon the Town Cost and Chery
