 March the 8: 1719: 20 Capt Richard Kimball Moderator  
 then was Chosen for Constable for the East End of the Town Joseph Hall  
 the Town of Bradford Esqrs of Robert Smithson for Constable  
 in Joseph Harris Room and John Griffin was Chosen Constable for  
 the West End of the Town

for select men were Chosen Thomas Carlton Doerren Richard  
 Bonly Richard Haseltine Scamuel Hale Moses Day

Wethersmith 3 Yecker were Chosen Town Clerk  
 for Surveyors of High Ways were Chosen for the west End of the  
 Town wethersmith 3 Yecker and John Hall  
 for Surveyors of high ways and fences for the East End of the Town  
 were Chosen Capt John Hutchings and for Daniel Herby  
 for Tything were Chosen John Geigtson Robert Haseltine William Scamuel  
 and John Pemberton

In answer to a petition of sundry persons hereafter  
 named viz Scamuel Webster John Kimball Thomas Stiche  
 Richard Kimball Ebenezer Chadwick and Moses Wolter for the kind  
 seat in the narrow side of the meeting house to reach a pew for  
 three wives to sit in. It being motion and passed on the petition that the  
 persons first named should have it with this proviso that they take care  
 for three women more and not to straiten any other seats

At a legal town meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Bradford  
 the 7 of aprill 1720 Capt Richard Kimball moderator, voted and consented  
 that the town would make three Rods to the quarter session by the select men with  
 Capt Richard Kimball a board the highway through the town of Bradford  
 by petitioners for sundry persons in Bradford town upon the towns East and West  
 ends and the town to reach the East End of Robert Haseltine four  
 rods long and wethersmith 3 Yecker to settle the line between Bradford  
 and Bradford
