At a Legal Towns meeting of the ~~Justices~~ ^{Justices} of the Towns
of Bradford Capt Richard Kimball moderator March the 14 1720
A petition then presented to the Towns by John Bishop David Wood
Edmond Brewster Benjamin Searcy That whereas there is
vacant place under the windows gallery stairs adjoining to m^{rs} Green
place at present is of but little service therefore we your humble
petitioners pray that the place might be granted unto us to
make a piece of which if you please to grant we shall for
ever pray

In answer to the petition four men shaid It being voted and
passed on the Affirmative that the petitioners should have so
much of that place to make a piece in memory and form as
the piece on the East end west sides of the meeting house
as I did understand by the moderator I being not present

Kimball and Constable for Bradford In testimony whereof we your
petitioners and the Justices of the Towns of Bradford do meet
this 21st of March 1720 at three of the clock in the afternoon
at which time we went as to taking some grass at large and to the
house of Thomas Kimball the Constable in James Wood's room
Witness our hands and seals the 21st of March 1720
