

At a Legal Town meeting of The inhabitants of the Town of Bradford the 23 of March 1721 Elder Samuel Tenen Moderator
 1st being voted and passed on the affirmative that if Swine shall go at large for this present year as the law Directs
 2nd voted and Consented to that the Towns Did Except of Thomas Kimball for to be Constable for the Towne for this present year in the Room of James Wood

At a Legal Town meeting of the Inhabitants of the Town of Bradford held the 16 of October 1721 Capt Richard Kimball Moderator it was first voted and passed on the affirmative that the Town wth Draw out there proportion of the fifty six hundred and then proceeds to give them the following Rule not to let any one more than two hundred pounds nor less than five and with in must at five o'clock

At a legal Town meeting of the Inhabitants of the Town of Bradford the 6 of November 1721 Capt Richard Kimball Moderator it was first voted and passed on the affirmative that the Town wth Draw out there proportion of the fifty six hundred and then proceeds to give them the following Rule not to let any one more than two hundred pounds nor less than five and with in must at five o'clock

Taken up a Stray heifer by William Hardy March 1721 of Bradford supposed to be coming in three years old with skin white on her back and in her other parts of her body with a crop on the right ear with a slit in the crop with a slit on the upper side of the left ear Decemr 21 1721

At a legal Town meeting of The Inhabitants of the Town of Bradford held the 21 of December 1721 Elder Samuel Tenen Moderator These sumes which are Due to the parsons here after named were allowed and appropriated by the Town of Bradford Namely for the widows Slickner for buying Hannah Sage - 06-00
 for the school master - 22-10-00
 for sweeping the meeting house - 01-10-00
 for the select men for making the Country Rate - 01-06-00
 for the Building of a pound - 03-00-00
 for the Constables - 01-05-00
 for a lock for the meeting house door - 00-04-00
 for Elder Samuel Tenen for being Deputy - 09-04-00
 for Mr Robert Hazell for being Deputy - 06-16-00
 for Capt Richard Kimball for being Representative - 02-00-00
 for John Muliken for making a glass ale - 00-12-00

There is taken up a Stray Bull by Joseph Hall of Bradford about one year old of a black color with a brown list on his back and Brown Round his horns with a white about his belly with a half crop on the under side of the left ear January the 1 1721/22
