Then was voted and passed in the Affirmative that the
Select men are Impowred to provide the Town with a
School master — & by it was voted that the select men
may Improve the School houses for the Entertaining any
poor families and not hindring the towns Schooling

At a Legal Town meeting held march 13: 1721/22
it was voted and passed in y^e Affirmative y^e for y^e future
y^e whereas y^e Justable shall Receive a Warrant to
warn a town meeting y^e Justable may set up a notification
upon y^e meeting hous and it shall be accounted Legal
and y^e Sofficant waving

Agust y^e 17th 1722 taking up by Ebenezer Worcester of Bradford
two Swine Damons & impounded them y^e marks y^e y^e Swine
are as followeth one white Ramms Swine with a banded head
and one spotted pig black and banded, one spotted Sow
white and black and one pig with black spot on y^e hind
being a rough pig with a yoke on one pig spotted black & white

December the ninth 1724 a record made of a horse of
John Jaquis of Bradford of a ^{dark} bay Colour a white
Blaze in his face Som. whit on both his hind feet a black
main & a black tail
