At a meeting of a Community Chosen by Bosford to Joyn
with Bradford select men to settle y^e line between the
abovd Towns Bosford men by name were Deput John p^r abov
and Insign John Peate and Sergeant Joseph Byggs by the name
the names of Bradford men were Coryell Robert Woodstons
and Thomas Kimball and Samuel Lenny they do agree that
a pine tree shall be the bound standing upon a narrow line
and so a black oak upon the Southwest end of John Simmonds
field and then to a white oak standing neere the Centrey road as
it goeth by the house that was John Peckers Deced from thence
to a white oak marked with an sanduk and a p with a heap of Rocks
about it as witness our hands for anybody Robert Woodstons

at a legal town hold march the 12 / 1722/3 CC Robert Woodstons
and Clark Thomas Kimball were Chosen to Run the line between
Bosford and Bradford

March the 22 / 1722/3 at a legal town meeting hold by the Inhabitants
of Bradford Elder Samuel Lenny moderator it was agreed and
passd on y^e aforesaid that Bradford town did then Except of
the abovd Return of the Community of Bosford and Bradford to
be a settled line between each town Runing from bound to bound
as is abovd specified

we the subscribers being select men and others appointed by
the select men of the Town of Kenoly and the town of Bradford
to perambulate the line between sd towns and met on the
twenty second day of this instant May and viewed the bound betw
sd towns and agreed to them as witness our hands Dated march the 22
1723
