Bradford held March the 17: 1723/4 Elders

All the town officers were sworn to their offices
at the above meeting the town of Bradford made choice of
Capt. Kimball Clark Robert Hallett & John Wilson as a committee
and Impowered them to Joine with the town of
Lind to settle a ward which shall be a standing line for the
future betwixt Bradford & Bradford

at the above meeting the town of Bradford made choice of
Capt. Kimball Capt. Woodman & Thomas Carlton for
James Bailey to view the mill dams and Impowered them to make
Provision for the fish to goe up to Johnsons Mill if they can
do it with five or ten pound Cost 4 at the above meeting the
town voted and allowed Capt. Kimball fifteen shillings
of pay for his representing the town at 3 Courts to be payd out
of the towns stock by the select men at the last meeting
Elders Samuel Tenney Deacon Robert H. Wilson & Richard Bailey was
chosen a committee for to seat the meeting house

at the annual town meeting held in march 1724/5 was chosen
Capt. Kimball Elders Tenney Moxley Samuel Hall and Richard
Bailey a committee for to settle the meeting house
