Cap Richard Kimball Moderator it was acted and passed
in the affirmative that when at any time here
after the Easterne End of this Town shall by the
General Court be set of as a parish to the ministry
that after the space of ten years from this time the meeting
house shall be removed into the center of which remaining
at the west End of the Town not set of to the East end of
the Town to be done after the said ten years is expired
at the motion of Ten or Twelve of the Inhabitants of
and in case of disagreement where the center is or may
be found it shall be stated by a committee chosen for that
end it is to be understood that if said western End of the
Town be any ways instrumental of dividing the town
or setting of the East end of the Town the vote shall
be void and of no effect
