for the East End of the town for select men was chosen John  
Glutkins Daniel Jago's Deacon William Yards Nehemiah Coit  
and Jonathan Kimball Richard Bailey was chosen John Clark  
for ferriars of highways was chosen Robert Savory Jonathan Wade  
for the East End of the town for the West End of the town Nathaniel  
Gage and Abraham Healdstone for fence viewers was chosen two  
Thomas Kimball and John Chalkickin for tax assessors was chosen  
Daniel Jago's Lee Richard Healdstone William Hardy and Thomas  
Hardy for timber measurers was chosen Ebenezer Burdick and  
Moses Gage it was also voted that history of a typical road at  
each meeting house in our parish eight days before hand shall  
for time to come be accounted publick warning for town meetings  
it was also voted that twenty should go at large to present year  
and for hog receipts was chosen Edward Tenney Jacob Hardison  
Nathaniel Healdstone Nathaniel Gage all the above officers was  
sworn to their respective offices as the law directs Excepting  
Daniel Jago's and William Harding men

At a Legall Town meeting held may the 12 1730 by the  
freeholders and other inhabitants of Bradford  
Moderator it was voted wheather the Town would buy ahy  
way through Days Land from and over Road to Gages  
ferry and it passed in the negative at the same time  
it was voted wheather the Town would mend and maintain  
the highways by rate and it passed in the negative also at  
same time it was voted wheather the Town would allow  
the select men any thing for there service this yeare  
and it passed in the negative
