

Now on the 2 day 1730 at a legal Town meeting  
 held by the Inhabitants of Bradford for to approve  
 Town Debt and several other things ~~the~~ Captin Kimbal  
 moderator it was voted that select men should provide  
 the Town with a Schoolmaster and to Raise moneys and  
 lay it in the Town Rate for the Schoolmasters Salary  
 2ly was voted ten Shilings for the Trusties Capt Kimbal  
 Clark Kimbal Cornet Buckley  
 3ly it was voted that aforesd Trusties should have  
 three pound of moneys of the Town that is <sup>in</sup> hand  
 4ly it was voted twelve pound for Edward  
 Hardy for the Road that is laid out through <sup>his</sup> land 12-0-0  
 5ly was voted that Captin Kimbal should be allowed  
 for aforesd Road that goes through his land  
 for length of poul according of Leut Hardys pay.  
 6ly was voted that the select men should allow  
 any small Debts that is due from the Town to any  
 particuler persons and to lay it in the Town Rate  
 that are not approved  
 at the aforesd meeting was chosen a Comity namely  
 Decen Hall Lev. Tidney Kimbal Richard Beveloy  
 to give a full Discharge to the aforesd Trusties  
 of the Towns Interest moneys it was also voted  
 that the select men should lay the County Rate with  
 the Town Rate.
