Kimbal and Benjamin Gage for Scavars of a year w<sup>ch</sup> chosen  
Joseph Richardson Elizer Burbank Elisha Nancy Samue  
Kimballin for Samuel Burell and Thibault Walker for fence  
viewers w<sup>ch</sup> chosen David Wood and John Kimbal for viewing  
men w<sup>ch</sup> w<sup>ch</sup> chosen Elisha Gering Deacon Hardy and David  
Kimbal and Benjamin Kimbal for hog keepers w<sup>ch</sup> chosen  
Jonas Bensen and Jonathan Hardy and John Dav and Richard  
Pearl for a Towne Treasurer w<sup>ch</sup> chosen Sergeant Thomas  
Kimbal and the select men w<sup>ch</sup> chosen a Committee to view  
the highway through Leut Hardy's land and the other place  
mentioned and make true Report to the Town those w<sup>ch</sup> w<sup>ch</sup>  
officers were sworn to their respective Offices Excepting  
Deacon Hardy and Richard Pearl  
Richard Bailey w<sup>ch</sup> chosen Town Clerk *In favor to Resolved*

it was voted and pass in the affirmative that the Town  
shold goe at large this year

voted and pass in the negative and also to vote if the

Mr Bacon now lieth provided the Town be at no Charge  
about 10 feary with respect to highway and the Town  
wouded there Consent and it pass in the affirmative  
this about meeting was held the 15 of May 1732
