of the Town of Bradford for choice of Town officers  
on March the 13/ 1732/3 Richard Bailey Moderator  
was Chosen Constable James Curran and Robert Satterly  
for select men was Chosen Constable Gage and Benjamin  
William Hardy and Benjamin Thirsten and John  
Bay and Jonathan Bailey for a Town Clerk was  
Chosen Richard Bailey and Capt. Thomas Kimball  
was Chosen Town Treasurer for Surveyors of highways  
was Chosen Thomas Stickney Samuel Calmer  
Thomas Hardy Samuel Gage and Ephraim Kimball  
and Edmond Chadwick for fence viewers was  
Chosen Robert Melleckim and Joseph Kimball  
for tithing men was Chosen Ebenezer Kimball  
and Lete Thomas Bailey and Nathaniel Gage  
and Samuel Heabettie for hog Lots was Chosen  
Nathan Bailey Moses Wautter and John Jacques  
and Job Kimball for timber measures was Chosen  
Thomas Stickney and Moses Gage voted that  
~~the~~ swine shall goe at large this year and  
the above officers was sworn to their offices  
Excepting Lete Thomas Bailey

at a legal Town meeting held by the Inhabitants of  
the Town of Bradford the 26 of July 1733 Samuel Gage  
Moderator to try the minds of the Town whether they would  
chuse men for overseers of the poor for this present year  
and they voted and it passed in the negative and also  
what the Town would <sup>doe</sup> in respect to a school matter and  
it passed in the negative also to see what the Town  
would in respect to a sick man brought to the select  
men and it passed in the negative
