fiv yearz Insewing at the above sd meeting it was  
voted and passed in the offermetius that the Town  
of Bradford would allow seven pounds to Robert  
Kimball for the defraying of the Charge that he was  
at in keeping the Gresh man that is sick at his house  
at the above sd meeting it was voted and passed in the  
offermetius that the Town would allow fower pound  
to henw Miller to pay the last years Rent of his  
Livering that he lives on

at the above sd meeting Cornt John Fluckings and  
Robert Saueroy & Brad Cheney & Thomas Saueroy &  
John Hopkinson and Jonas Platts junr Entered there  
Recounts against the Towns allowing the 7 pounds to Robert  
Kimball

\* August the 1 - 1733 Taken up by Eliezer Burd-  
nck of Bradford one black Ewe marked with a  
Swallow tail in the right eare a half penny the under  
side the same the left eare Cropt and two white  
Ewes and a white rane lamb marked with the left eare  
Cropt a half penny in the upper side the <sup>same</sup> right eare  
and a half top the upper side the right eare  
another white Ewe marked with a slit in the left eare  
and two nicks in the upper side of the right eare

December the tenth 1733 taken up by Joseph Kimball of  
Bradford a stray there supposed to be coming in three  
years old of a blackish color with a brown list on his  
back and a brown nose with a larg notch the under side the  
left eare a peard of said eare hanging down supposed  
to be torn with dogs
