9. voted to Decon Hardy and Benjamin Hardy for maintaining
 between Rowley and Bradford - 00 06 00

- voted that the select men have Liberty to lay the
 County and town Rates together - 00 15 00
- voted at Daniel Gage in behalf of his son Daniel

- voted that the select men hear the Request of
 Decon Haffelme with respect to the charge of
 William Ferrys being removed out of town and allow the
 charge if they think it Reasonable
- voted that the select men are empowered to call in former
 select men to an account with respect to the clearing and good
 of Sout^h Bishops
- voted to Ephraim Kimball and Christopher Barthlet
