

At a Legal Town Meeting of the Inhabitants of the Town of
Bradford upon a Town Meeting March the 20th 1733

- 1 voted and passed in the affirmative to build a school house at the
west end of St. Jasons eighteen feet wide and twenty two feet in length
and about eleven feet high and also that the school house be
on the East Corner of Leion Hill Land by the Congregational Road
- 2 voted also that Leion Hill Land by the Congregational Road
be a Committee to build a school house on the East
- 3 voted also that the committee may use the money raised which
is in Leion Hill Land towards the building of the school house
- 4 James Kimball Esq. was chosen an Auditor for the Town to
prepare a petition of Appeal to the Court with respect to the money
paid from St. Jasons to the River
