

Bosford June the 5: 1740

As the Subscribers being met to preambulate the Line
between Bradford and Bosford on said day have
Renewed the Bounds as followeth viz a pine or pillar
of Stone being the bounds between Andover
Bosford and Bradford also a white oak tree being
the bounds between Rowley Bradford and Bosford and
all the Rest of the Bounds on said Line Except
a Stump mentioned in y^e agreement so called
which is between Watsons Bounds and a pine by
Littel pond and a Stump Near Summery fence
the which Bosford Committee would not Consent
to Renew all the Rest of the bounds we have agreed
to according to our power and Authority
