no horns and marked with a hole in the Right Ear and
half penny in each Side of the Same Ear and is Crooked
on 7^{th} Rump and on 7^{th} back Side of his Neck

Taken up by Eldred Cheney of Bradford ^{white} Ram going
at Large October on 15^{th} 1745 and are marked the one
with a Crook off the Left Ear and a half penny in the
under side of 7^{th} Right Ear the other marked with
a Swallow tale in 7^{th} Right Ear and a half penny in the
under side of the Same and a notch in 7^{th} upper side
of the Same Ear

Newbery September the 27^{th} 1745
we the Subscribers being a panted by Newbery and Bradford
to preblate the Line between Newbery and Bradford the bounds
are as followeth first bounds at Merrimack River a Stake
heap of stones At high water mark the second a heap of stones
about fifty or sixty Rods from the River the third bounds a flat
stone to 7^{th} South of Bradford Road the fourth bounds a Red oak
Standing by a white oak the fifth bounds a heap of stones on
Six feet Northwardly from a stump the sixth bounds a heap of
about five feet Eastwardly from a black oak tree the seventh
a heap of stones by a stump the eighth bounds a heap of stones
by a stump the ninth bounds a heap of stones by a tree the
tenth bounds a Elm tree marked with N on the westwardly Side the
eleventh bounds a Rock in Mr. Marsh Stone wall 7^{th} thirteenth bounds a
heap of stones by a stump Southwardly of a Swamp the fourteenth bounds
Large white oak tree marked with N. on both Sides of 7^{th} fifteenth
a Large Red oak on a Ledger of Rock the sixteenth bounds
and heap of stones Southwardly of a beaver brook 7^{th} seventeenth
a Large white oak tree marked with N and S 7^{th} eighteenth
a white oak tree between Newbery Rowley and Bradford
