Whereas Moses Day and Daniel Gage did make
an offer that if the Town would signify
their desire that the sd Moses Day and Daniel
Gage should have a ferry at the place where sd
Day hath kept a for some time provided
these men or their heirs and successors
do provide ways on them on Cost and Charge
viz that the sd Moses Day do find a way
from the lane that goeth towards his
house from the Gages to find it through
his his land to the Country Road as it
goeth to and over and that sd Daniel Gage
find a way from sd ferry to the Country Road
at Capt. Wood Brick house and also
sd lane that is between Nathaniel Gage and
and John Gage
that then the Towne do Desire this ferry
may Be settled on sd Moses Day and on
sd Daniel Gage and their heirs forever
