Moderator voted and allowed to Deon Hall Seventeen Shilling pr week for Boarding the Schoolmaster ad tenor allowed to Thomas Kimball Esq. for his boarding said Schoolmaster Seventeen Shilling pr week voted that one hundred & fifty pounds be raised for schooling and other yances for y town to be Drawn out by order of the Select men

voted to Jonathan Hale for Serving Constable - - 2-10-0
 voted to Moses Day for Serving Constable - - 2-10-0
 voted to Cap^t Mulliken for Serving town. redior - 5-0
 voted to Wchemish Carlton for Repairing y^e West Schoolhouse - 5-0
 voted to Abraham Gage for a Journey of his horse to Cambridge to Carry the Schoolmaster 0-15-0
 voted to Cap^t Kimball for Repairing the middel Schoolhouse 0-5-0

it was put to vote whether the town would abate the heads of such parsons who are or have bin in his Maj^{ty} the Service this year & y vote passed in y^e Affirmative

it was all put to vote whether the town will allow William Hardy pay for the town Road that goeth across his Land and y vote passed in y^e Affirmative
