 voted to Deacon Carlton for what he Expended In
 Supporting Mr. Phillips ----- 23 = 15 = 1
 voted that Eighty poundⁿ be raised for the
 use of the poor & to be Drawn out of the Treasury
 by order of the Selectmen ----- 80 = 0 = 0
 voted to Daniel Gages for going to Ipswich Court
 as an agent for the town ----- 02 = 0 = 0
 voted and allowed to Deacon Carlton for his
 Service in taking Care of the poor ----- 05 = 0 = 0
 voted and allowed to Leut. Gage and
 Joseph Kimball for there Service in preambulating
 on the Line between Bradford & Woxford 0 = 15 = 0
 In all ----- 01 = 10 = 0
