

Taken up by Edmund Kimball of Bradford on the Second Day of December 1751 a Stray Horse of about fourteen hands high and of a Cormel Collier and a Lite Colored mane and tail and a white star in his forehead and a Little white Spot on his back. & the Saddle place being well Shod round and Supposed to be about twelve years old having no Artificial mark.

Taken up by Samuel Wobman of Berlin on the ninth Day of December 1751 a Stray horse of about fourteen hands high of a Cormel Collier with small Star in his forehead being well shod round and Supposed to be about five years old having no Artificial mark.

Esq: Sir to John Hephinson one of the Constable of the town of Bradford Greeting these are to will and require you in his Majesties Name forthwith to warn the freeholders and other Inhabitants of said town Qualified for voting as the Law Directs that they assemble and meet together at if well meeting house in said Town on Tuesday the twenty fourth Day of this instant march at ten of the Clock in the forenoon on said Day firstly to Chuse Town Officers for the year ensuing as the Law Directs 2ly to see if the town will abate Jonathan Kimball his province Rate and town Rate for the Year 1750 as Set in Constable Daniel Dagge List 3ly to see if the town will give Instruction to the Selectmen to order the treasurer of said town to pay to the Schoolmaster for his Service one third part of the year 8=17=9 Lawfull money and to saye Rath for ordering said Schoolmaster one half of said Term 8=18=8 & to sent them to Suckley 8=18=8 for biding said Schoolmaster the other term A ly to see if the town will allow Nathaniel Hardy 0=19=9 for keeping of Jonathan peffle as agreed with 5ly to see if the town will allow the Selectmen three shillings for their Extraordinary Charge in taking care of said Peffer or alse to see what the town will allow John Simmons for taking care of Martha Simmons our neare Relation heares with your Doing therem to us the Subscribers at or before of time appointed for said Meeting given under our hand in Bradford Market the 14: 1752 & in the 24 year of his majesties Reign
