 called Isaac Kimball's Corner where Salam and Newbery Roads Come together
 and if the vote pass in the affirmative then to se if the town will Chuse
 a Comitee to se the work affected on the town Vest
 as also to se if the town will abate Josiah Sepions c-6-3 which he was
 rated to Asa Merrell head in Constable David Hall's List
 and make Return hereof with your Doings there in to us the Suberiors
 on or before the time appointed for said meeting This at Bradford March 5. 1753
