 Keping Hanah Gage this year after the Rate of fourteen pounds the year and  
 allso that the docters bill be alowed him if he bring it to Select men in a fortnite  
 time

for peramalatin It was voted to Ensin Caleb Hopkinson and Cornet John Huchins  
 and Eldad Chainey thomas Carlton four Shilings to Each of them 0 - 16s 0  
 allso to Joseph willson and John Day two Shilings to Each of them 0 - 4s 0  
 to Ebenezer Kimball and Benjamen mulicam be paid five Shilling and four  
 pence apeace if they bring the age [sic] of their printeses to the Select men  
 timely

allso that the Select be paid 30 Shilings for their vears Servis
