at a Legail Town meeting held by the Inhabetence of the Town of Bradford upon ajournment from the 20 of november 1732 to the 18th of December 1732 Cornet John Huchins moderater then the Town did Except of the Report of the Select men by a voat who ware Chosen a Commity at the aneual Town meeting held by the Inhabetence of Bradford on march the 21 / 1731/2 to vew the Road that was layd out from Capt Daniel Hardys to Rowley line or make aney alteration on the Same and allsoe to vew the Road pertioned for by Decon Hardy and the Report of the sd Commety was that there Judgments was that the way by Decon Hardy is most beneficial to the Publeck and as little dameg to the price of it being so much les travel provided sd pertitonrs make sd way good and sizable to the Exceptence of a commety that may be Chosen
