and Request have laid out sd way begining at a white oak tre
on the west Side of the Town Road that leads from the high
way to Eliezers Burbanks first going upon Tho Hardys
Land 2 Rod wide where the Rode now is to Ebenzer Burbanks
Land then on sd Burbanks Land to Joseph Hardys land to be
2 Rods wide and upon the Road againt sd Burbanks
barn to be four Rods wide and soe a cros sd Hardys
land as the Road now lies to be 2 Rode wide to Joseph
Hardy iur Land and soe as the Road now Lyes to John Har
dys land and then upon the line between John Hardy and
Jacob Hardy iun apowle upon Each and Soe upon the
line betwene Joseph and Jacob a powl on Each mans
lot till it coms to Joseph Hardy iuners land and soe as
the Road now lyes to Long Meadow and over and then turning
westward as nere the Swampe as may be to Jacob Hardy
juners fenced this Road we have Laid out as a perticuler way
for the use and benefite of these persons and there families
above mentioned to be an open Road for them and there
Hiers for Ever
