

Boxford June the 5 : 1740

We the Subscribers being met to preambulate the Line between Bradford and Boxford on Said Day have Renewed the bounds as followeth viz a pine or pillar of Stones being the bounds between Andover Boxford and Bradford allso a white oke tree being the bounds between Rowley Bradford and Boxford and all the Rest of the bounds on Said Line Except a Stompt mentioned in th^e agreement So Called which is between Watsons bounds and a pine by Little pond and a Stumpt Near Simmons fence the which Boxford Committee would not Consent to Renew all the Rest of the bounds we have agreed to according to our power and Athority

Taken up by Samuel Palmer of Bradford a white Ram going at Large October 6 : 1741
Contrery to th^e Laws of th^e province he having no horns and marked with a half peney in th^e under Side of the Left Ear

Taken up by Thomas Savery of Bradford a white Ram going at Large on th^e 13 of October 1741 he having a Large Set of horns and marked with a Crop of the End of (illegible) and two Noches in th^e under Side of Same
